

Appeal to Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II

In September 2010, David Walter appealed to Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II. Many of you will have received the package of data we had prepared and sent to the Queen.

Signed Letter to HM's Private Secretary - 8.2010

On her behalf, the reply received stated that Her Majesty was our Constitutional Sovereign and we should talk to the Governor-General.

Response from Buckingham Palace 2.9.2010

So, David has done just that.

Letter to Governor-General 7 April 2011

The Governor-General Quentin Bryce is being asked to provide all the lawful documentation to establish the constitutional validity of the current Parliamentary structure.

The response to this request will be forwarded to Her Majesty.

As you will read on the last part of the letter to Quentin Bryce, David has asked her to lodge two Caveats on behalf of the People standing ex parte for Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II.

Caveat 1: ...to hold all of the commercial contracts, sold in land in fee simple or freeholding lease, that are signed and sealed between Her Majesty and any natural person or company in those said Colonies now States and Territories in the Commonwealth of Australia.

... to hold all of the personal, private and real property held in common law and equity to the Judiciary Act 1903, of Her Majesty as a natural person and all subjects of Her Majesty within the Commonwealth of Australia or persons outside the Commonwealth but holding legal commercial contracts with Her Majesty to the Commonwealth of Australia Constitution Act 1901, inter alia with the Commonwealth of Australia Constitution Act 1900 (UK) [63 & 64 Vict.] [Ch. 12].

... to protect the civil and political rights and liberties and property of all natural persons which include Her Majesty, inside of the Commonwealth of Australia Constitution Act 1901, inter alia with the Commonwealth of Australia Constitution Act 1900 (UK) [63 & 64 Vict.] [Ch. 12].

Caveat 1

Caveat 2: ...over the Parliament House of the Australian Government in Canberra in the Australian Capital Territory of Australia.

Caveat 2

We are asking that you the People, in what may be our final attempt to restore the Constitutional structure, support this letter to the Governor-General in three ways.

1. Forward this package to every Australian.
2. Write to the Governor-General and ask that she answer the letter of request and supply the documentation in that request
3. Add your support to the two Caveats, by
 - a. Requesting the Governor-General lodge both Caveats immediately
 - b. Forward your name and details to flora@reachnet.com.au to be added to the list of supporting Australians which will be forwarded to Her Majesty.

The Australian Government have borrowed against our personal assets and our Will are now lodged as collateral for that borrowing with the International Banks.

Without our permission.

We consider it vital that these Caveats be lodged. In the event that Australia finds itself facing any financial ruin, our personal land, our personal possessions, our personal wealth is the surety for that debt.

In the event that we are wrong and the Australian Government can provide lawful and constitutional documentation to prove that we live in and are protected by the constitutional structure created in 1900, then we can immediately lift the Caveats.

Until that time and that proof is provided, we individual Australians must stand together and protect both our ourselves, our friends and neighbours and our Queen, through these measures.
